To make a supplemental appropriation for the Public Health Emergency Fund, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Public Health Emer-
- 5 gency Preparedness Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE PUBLIC
- 7 HEALTH EMERGENCY FUND.
- 8 (a) APPROPRIATION.—There is appropriated, out of
- 9 any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,

for an additional amount for carrying out section 319(a) of the Public Health Service Act, \$5,000,000,000, to be 3 available until expended. Such amount shall be deposited into the Fund established under section 319(b) of such 5 Act. 6 (b) EMERGENCY DESIGNATION.—The amount made 7 available by subsection (a)— 8 (1) is designated by Congress as an emergency 9 requirement pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) of the 10 Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control 11 Act of 1985; and 12 (2) shall be available only if the President sub-13 sequently so designates such amount. 14 (c) Deposit in Strategic National Stockpile.— 15 The activities under section 319(a) of the Public Health Service Act that are funded under this section may include 16 17 the acquisition of products for deposit into the strategic national stockpile maintained under section 319F-2 of 18 19 such Act. SEC. 3. EXEMPTION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY 21 FUND FROM SEQUESTRATION. 22 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 255(g)(1)(A) of the Bal-23 anced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended by inserting "Public Health Emergency Fund

- 3 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by sub-
- 4 section (a) shall apply to any sequestration order issued
